OVERLAND TRAIL

The Overland Trail was an old stagecoach route established in 1862 to avoid the Indian uprisings which were occurring on the Oregon Trail farther north through central Wyoming. The Overland trail became the only emigrant route on which the United States Government would allow travel to the west from 1862 to 1868. TAKE A DAY TRIP to visit the remnants of...

Point of Rocks Stage Station, Granger Station and Fort Bridger

Directions from Rock Springs/Green River KOA to Point of Rocks Stage Station

Take I-80 East to Exit 130, 1/2 mile south of exit.

Directions from Rock Springs/Green River KOA to Granger Station

Take I-80 West to Exit 66; US Highway 30; within Granger City Limits.

Directions from Rock Springs/Green River KOA to Fort Bridger

Take I-80 West to Exit 34 then go approximately 3 miles south of Evanston.
